

Streaming From PC to TM9100 Using VLC Client

Install "VLC Media Player 0.8.1" on your PC

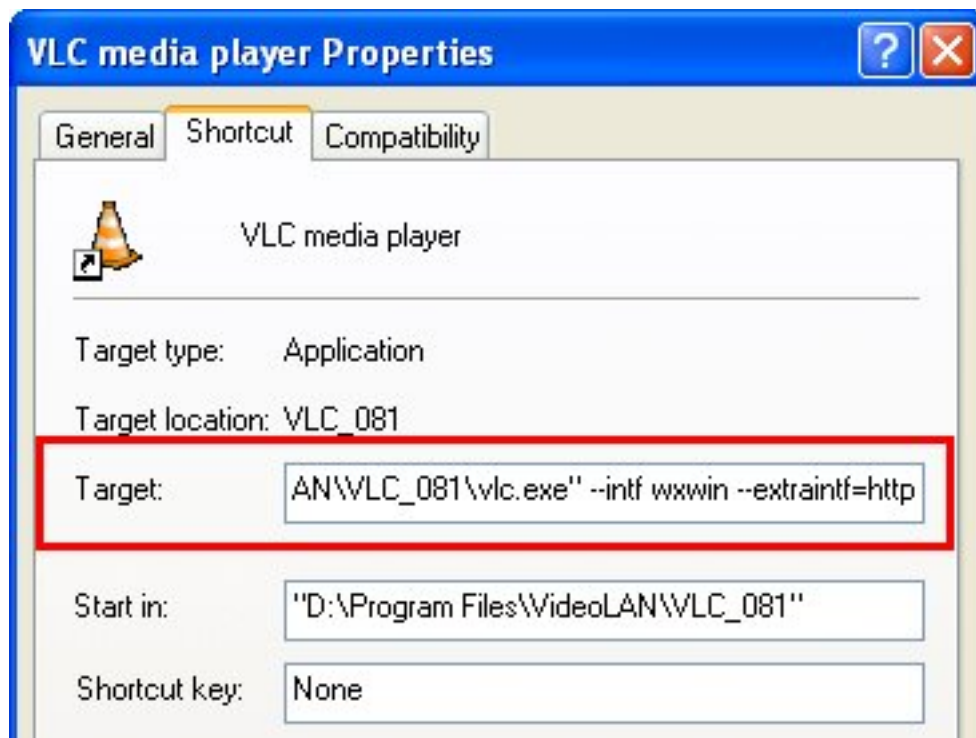
If you already have installed on your PC a newer version of VLC but you still want to install version 0.8.1 in a different folder to be used to watch Xvid/DivX with your TM9100 you can do that since there are no problems with other existing versions. Just install to a different folder name and uncheck all install options. If you are using version 0.8.1 only, please select and check all install options instead



This is needed to avoid any possible mess with Start menu and not to overright the latest browser plugin

Select "VLC media player" icon on your desktop (create one if you don't have one) and right click with your mouse to select "Properties". Go to "Shortcut" and write after exe name:

`--intf wxwin --extraintf=http`



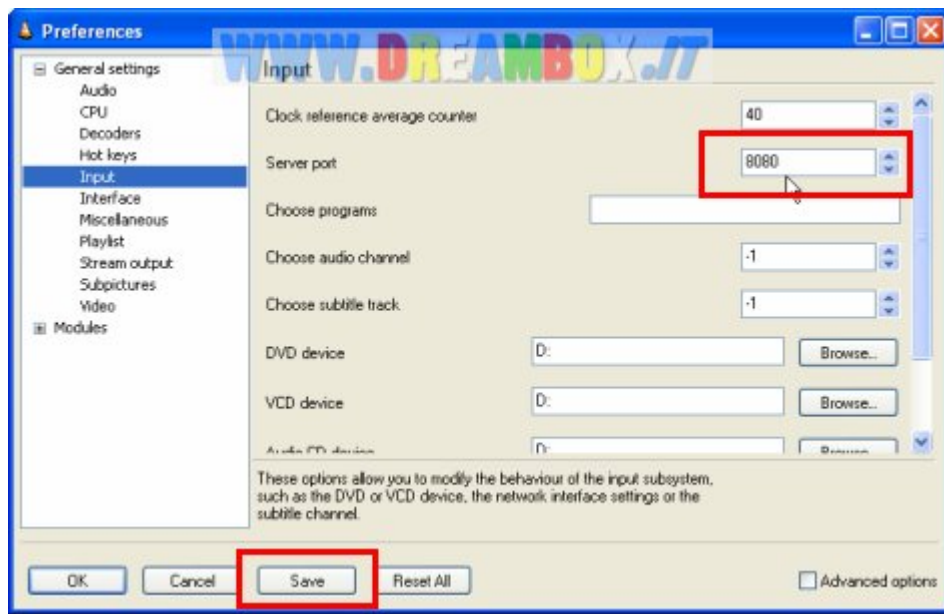
Run "VLC Media Player 0.8.1" by clicking icon you just edited

If you get following warning message select "Unblock"



Start VLC and go to "Settings" then "Preferences"

Select "Input" in the list at left of program window, input 8080 in "Server port" and save by clicking on "Save" key at the bottom, then quit the program



Open with "Notepad" "vlc.xml" file in "VLC Client 0.2.3" plugin

Put your pc IP in "server ip" then the full path to your PC folder where divx files are stored where it says "config startdir" picture see below

Save file and quit "Notepad"
